



Over the course of weeks and months, He regularly reminded me that I wasn't forgotten. I was soon blessed with friends that genuinely cared for me, as well as an incredible job. More laborers and encouragement arrived in Bryant and Maggie Rouse a year later and people gradually started attending our church services. The Lord allowed us to purchase our first home and we are excited to welcome our first child, a baby boy, in October. Fulfillment and purpose soon replaced the loneliness and fear.

I would never trade my life in Utah for anything and I am proud to call this place home.




Spring Conference 2016
