***The completion and graduation rates for certificates, associate degrees, and bachelor degrees are measured at 150% of the expected time for completion (bachelor degree rate is 6 years from the first enrollment).*

First-to-Second Year Retention Rates

Retention rates measure the percentage of first-time students who are seeking bachelor's degrees or associate degrees who return to the institution to continue their studies the following fall.

The percentage of students who began their studies at SFWBC in Fall 2024 and returned in Fall 2025 was 76%.

Overall Graduation Rate

The overall graduation rate tracks the progress of students who began their studies as full-time, first-time degree-seeking students to see if they complete a degree or other award such as a certificate within 150% of "normal time" for completing the program in which they are enrolled.

Note that not all students at SFWBC are tracked for these rates. Students who have already attended another postsecondary institution, or who began their studies on a part-time basis, are not tracked for this rate.

The transfer-out rates within 150% of "normal time" for full-time, first-time students who began their studies in Fall 2019 was 27%.

The percentage of Baccalaureate full-time, first-time students who graduated within 150% of “normal time” to completion for their program at SFWBC for students who began their studies in Fall 2019 was 43%.

The percentage of Associate full-time, first-time students who graduated within 150% of “normal time” to completion for their program at SFWBC for students who began their studies in Fall 2019 was 100%.

Student-to-Faculty Ratio

The current student-to-faculty ratio is 8 to 1.

Job Placement Rates

The graduates of the Class of 2025 have a Job Placement Rate of 93%.

Graduate Satisfaction Rate

93% of our recent graduates reported being very satisfied or generally satisfied with their college experience and academic training at SFWBC.
